APPLICATION FORM

The Nottingham Society of Artists was founded in 1880, making it one of the oldest art societies in the country. It is a charitable company limited by guarantee, overseen by a Board of Directors, who are elected at the AGM. The Society owns and administers the whole of St Luke's House which comprises an excellent gallery on the ground floor, a gallery/education studio on the first floor, a large top-floor studio, and a basement. All three main floors have kitchens and cloakrooms.

Any person aged 18 or over may join the Society at any time. There is an annual subscription of £85, due in April, payable on joining. If you join in November or December the joining fee is reduced to £45 and if you join between January and March it is reduced to £25. The fee is periodically revised in line with costs.

There is a 50% discount for under-25's. You will need to supply proof of age in the form of a photo of a document showing your date of birth, e.g. driving licence, passport, birth certificate, etc.

Members may participate in any of the extensive range of activities, and may exhibit in the annual painting groups exhibition, subject to space. Painting groups take place in the studio and in the field.

If you wish to become a member of the Society please complete the application form on page 3 and the consent form on page 4.

Please note: your personal details will be recorded in our membership database but will only be used for the purposes of running the Society.
